'80s ICONS TO OPEN BETHEL WOODS SEASON
ON JUNE 14
Tickets On Sale Now

BETHEL, NY (June 5, 2008) – The first concert of the season at Bethel Woods Center for the Arts is just around the corner. Cyndi Lauper brings her True Colors tour to Bethel Woods on Saturday, June 14. The tour started on May 31st in Boston, making stops in New York City and Chicago, and has been met with rave reviews ever since. Cyndi will be joined by The B-52s, comedian Rosie O'Donnell, The Cliks, Deborah Cox, and host Carson Kressley.

Situated at the site of the original 1969 Woodstock festival in Bethel, New York, The Bethel Woods Center for the Arts is entering its third exciting concert season at the 15,000 seat Pavilion Stage; and The Museum at Bethel Woods, which explores the legacy of the Sixties and Woodstock, is now open. Concert-goers will have the opportunity to purchase admission to The Museum in addition to their concert tickets, allowing them to enjoy all that Bethel Woods Center for the Arts has to offer.

After receiving rave reviews and a successful debut in 2007, the True Colors Tour is expanding to meet demand in many more cities. Produced by True Colors Concerts in partnership with the Human Rights Campaign (HRC), the 24-city North American tour is presented by the LOGO Network in support of the newly created True Colors Fund of Stonewall Community Foundation. The concert features nearly five hours of nonstop music. The True Colors Tour, conceived by Cyndi Lauper, is a celebration of the basic values and freedoms shared by all Americans. Fans will experience these values through the music of both legendary icons and the newest and coolest acts this generation has to offer.

Reserved ticket prices are \$126.00, \$76.00, \$56.00 and \$26.00 for lawn. Doors open at 3:30 p.m. and the show will begin at 6 p.m.
